Placement fee	£50.00	Applies to all bookings.

ROOM COSTS

Single Room	£175.00 per week	1 student per room. 2 meals per day, 7 days per week.
Shared Room	£125.00 per week	2 students per room; must be friends studying together. 2 meals per day, 7 days per week.

SUPPLEMENTARY COSTS

Under 18 supplement	£35.00 per week	Applies to any student under the age of 18. Includes additional care and daily lunches.
Summertime supplement	£80.00 per week	Applies to all bookings in July and August. Places are limited; book early to avoid disappointment.
Christmas supplement	£80.00 per week	Applies to all bookings during the festive shutdown. Places are very limited; book early to avoid disappointment.
Special request	£45.00 per week	Applies to any person with dietary or room requirements. Includes halal or vegetarian diets, and en-suite bathrooms.

PLEASE NOTE

Homestay Accommodation is only available to full-time students studying for a minimum of 15 hours per week.

The UK is a nation of animal lovers, and most homestay hosts have pets. Dogs and cats are the most common, but you could also expect to find guinea pigs, hamsters, fish, or indoor birds. Pets will not be allowed in your room unless you want them to, but they are otherwise treated as part of the family.

You must be prepared to accept this if you choose homestay accommodation. We can only guarantee a pet-free homestay host if you provide a medical certificate and give us at least 4 weeks' notice of your requirement.

If you do not want to live with pets, we recommend residential accommodation; you will live in a town-centre student residence with the guarantee of a private room and no pets in the building.

PLEASE NOTE

Homestay Accommodation and Residential Accommodation are very different; neither is better, but each has its own advantages and disadvantages. It is important that you think about what is right for you and your lifestyle.

Homestay Accommodation is only available to full-time students studying for a minimum of 15 hours per week. Residential Accommodation is only available to students over the age of 18.

We're very happy to organise homestay or residential accommodation for you; in both cases, we will manage your booking and act on your behalf. Our Accommodation Officer visits and inspects both homestay and residential accommodation. Each homestay host will have their own house rules, and each residence is an independent business.

If you want to keep your belongings in your room while you are away from the area, a room retention fee will be charged. The room retention fee for homestay accommodation is £60.00 per week; the fee is normally 100% of the room price in residential accommodation.

If you decide to organise your own accommodation privately, please be aware that you will be responsible for costs and complexities which we cannot help you with. You will need to consider your tenancy agreement, the cost of council tax, and all service charges (such as electricity, water, and gas).
